Library Service Devolution

We have been in regular in-depth discussions with Cornwall Council regarding the possibility of taking on and continuing a library service in Hayle. A number of proposals are currently being considered; a decision by the Town Council is expected early in February 2017.

2017/2018 Precept Demand

The Town Council's precept has been finalized excluding the impact of taking on the Library building and/or service from Cornwall Council. The final Precept for 2017/18 cannot be confirmed until a decision has been made about the Town Council's role in potentially delivering this service.
