R44 TO RECEIVE APOLOGIES

R45 TO RECEIVE DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST AND REQUESTS FOR DISPENSATIONS

R46 TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE RESOURCE COMMITTEE MEETING 26 JANUARY 2023
