Hayle Open Air Swimming Pool

The pool opened on Saturday 24 June. Once again, the Friends of Hayle Pool gave their time to assist prior to opening for the season, thank you. The council also installed new windows and doors to changing rooms and a new entrance arrangement has been introduced. Each year a little more work is undertaken helping to steadily improve the loved facility. This year we are feeling the benefit of the solar, thermal covers that were installed at the end of the season 2016. The water is averaging a temperature of 24 degrees so there are no excuses not to come in and enjoy!

The pool is open daily from 11am till 6pm. The last day of this season is Sunday 10 September.

CCTV

The Council recently placed the order for 2 additional CCTV cameras to extend the coverage provided by the existing network. It is anticipated that SSE will be installing these imminently. They will cover the Recreation Ground and the far end of Copperhouse and the Penpol Terrace, harbour and Jubilee Bridge areas.
