Minutes of the Annual Hayle Town Council Meeting held at the Day Care Centre, Commercial Road, Hayle on Thursday 9 May 2019, commencing at 7.30pm.

The clerk informed the company that she would usually ask them to stand while she welcomed the mayoral party, but that this year they were already at the table.

7.30PM ANNUAL COUNCIL MEETING COMMENCED

ACM1 TO ELECT THE TOWN MAYOR FOR 2019/2020

The clerk invited Councillor Capper to nominate a councillor for Hayle Town Mayor. He nominated Councillor Polkinghorne giving a short speech stating it was his privilege to propose Councillor Polkinghorne for the role of mayor as he had proven to be an outstanding mayor the previous year. This was seconded by Councillor Cocks who said that it was an enormous pleasure and he had no hesitation in seconding him as he knew he would do as excellent a job in the forthcoming year as he had in the previous one.

There were no other nominations and **it was resolved** unanimously that Councillor Polkinghorne be elected Hayle Town Mayor for the year 2019/2020.

ACM2 TO RECEIVE THE TOWN MAYOR'S ADDRESS, INCLUDING THE STATUTORY DECLARATION OF ACCEPTANCE OF OFFICE & CONFIRMATION OF CONSORT

The clerk placed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office, which included an undertaking to abide by the council's adopted Code of Conduct, in front of the mayor who read and signed it before passing it back to the clerk for her signature (see Appendix A).

The mayor announced that his consort would be his wife, Sue Polkinghorne, and gave his acceptance speech, which was warmly received (see Appendix B). After his speech the mayor thanked Hayle Flower Club for doing the flowers and Hayle Day Care Centre for use of the room.

ACM3 TO ELECT THE DEPUTY TOWN MAYOR FOR 2018/2019

The clerk invited Councillor Polkinghorne to nominate a councillor as Hayle Deputy Town Mayor. He proposed Councillor Benney as Hayle Town Deputy Mayor commending him to the council in a short speech thanking him and saying that he had proven to be a fantastic deputy in the previous year. The nomination was seconded by Councillor Roden who wished Councillor Benney every success for his second year as deputy mayor, saying that he had worked diligently and tirelessly for Hayle as deputy mayor, following his dedicated service to the community before becoming a town councillor.

There were no other nominations and **it was resolved** unanimously that Councillor Benney be elected Hayle Town Deputy Mayor for the year 2019/2020.

ACM4 TO RECEIVE THE DEPUTY TOWN MAYOR'S ADDRESS, INCLUDING THE STATUTORY DECLARATION OF ACCEPTANCE OF OFFICE AND CONFIRMATION OF CONSORT

The clerk placed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office, which included an undertaking to abide by the council's adopted Code of Conduct, in front of the deputy mayor who read and signed it before passing it back to the clerk for her signature (see Appendix C).

The deputy mayor announced that his consort would be his wife, Suzanne Benney, and then presented a brief address during which he thanked the clerk and her team. He also thanked everyone for attending and congratulated Councillor Polkinghorne for being elected mayor for another year. He thanked Mrs Benney for accompanying him on the few civic occasions Councillor Polkinghorne had been unable to attend.

ACM5 TO PRESENT THE MAYOR'S ANNUAL AWARDS TO CITIZENS AND ORGANISATIONS OF THE YEAR

The mayor began by presenting replica trophies to the previous year's winners or their representatives: Alison Stuckey, 2018/2019 Female Citizen of the Year; John Broadbridge, 2018/2019 Male Citizen of the Year (posthumously awarded); Hayle RFC Colts, 2018/2019 Youth Organisation of the Year; and Macmillan Cancer Support Hayle Committee, 2018/2019 Organisation of the Year. The mayor thanked all of them for their service to the town.

The mayor announced that Mike Stuckey had been selected as Male Citizen of the Year 2019/2020 for his work with U3A and the Day Care Centre to which he dedicated many, many hours and for which he had raised a lot of money. Mr Stuckey accepted his award and gave a short speech of thanks and congratulated the mayor and deputy mayor on their election. He said it was an honour to give service to the community and gave a brief history of his prior involvement with the Hayle Twinning Association. He was proud to have worked with U3A and carried out many beach cleans on the best bit of coast around Cornwall. As a trustee and volunteer of the Day Care Centre he had been able to do his little bit to help the community. He said volunteering also helped him feel better and thanked everyone for enabling him to volunteer.

The mayor presented the award for Female Citizen of the Year 2019/2020 to Margaret Jamieson for her work with Save Our Sand Hayle and litter picking in the town. Unfortunately, Mrs Jamieson was unable to attend to receive her award due to her husband's ill health and Alison Stuckey



accepted the award on her behalf and read a short message from Mrs Jamieson which said that she was accepting it on behalf of a group of people who helped with the beach cleaning and Save Our Sand organisation.

The Young Person of the Year for 2019/2020 was Emily Brown, who had been nominated for her dedication to carrying out her duties as Mayor's Cadet the previous year and for her shining example to other young people. The mayor presented the award to Flight Lieutenant Mark Wardley on behalf of Sergeant Brown, who was unfortunately unwell and unable to attend. Flt Lt Wardley reported that Sgt Brown was very sad not to attend and was thrilled to receive the award. The mayor agreed to award it to her personally on a future occasion.

Hayle Royal British Legion was chosen to receive this year's award as Organisation of the Year, in particular for its Poppy Appeal fundraising for invalided and retired service personnel and its contribution to the centenary commemorations of the end of the First World War. Alan Conquest, President of the Hayle Branch of the Legion, came forward and said that the Legion's members were very proud and grateful to receive the award; he thanked the mayor and gave a short speech in which he highlighted that the Hayle branch had dispersed £200,000 of charitable aid over the last 25-30 years. He added that the mayor's organisation of the Poppy Appeal in November 2018 had been out of this world and that he should have been given the award!

Moving to the award for the Youth Organisation of the Year 2019/2020, the mayor chose to break with tradition and gave the award for the second time to the Hayle Surf Life Saving Nippers. Representatives of the Nippers received their award and gave a few words of thanks to the mayor and those who had nominated them. Holly, aged 12, was the girl Nipper captain; she said how much she enjoyed the club as she had had so many opportunities to make friends and do exciting things. Michael, also aged 12, was the Nipper captain of the boys; his favourite things about being a Nipper were the friends he had made, his coaches who were all volunteers, the competitions which gave him a 'fire in my belly' and the sea and the waves.

ACM6 TO PRESENT A TOWN PLATE TO JOHN BENNETT, FORMER HAYLE TOWN COUNCILLOR, IN RECOGNITION OF HIS OUTSTANDING SERVICE AS CHAIR OF THE HAYLE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN STEERING GROUP

The mayor welcomed John Bennett and announced how pleased he was to present a town plate to him. He gave a short speech about Mr Bennett's extensive contributions to the town but informed everyone that this award was especially for his many hundreds, if not thousands, of hours' work on the Hayle Neighbourhood Plan itself and chairing the Hayle Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group.


Mr Bennett accepted the plate and gave a very short speech of thanks.

The mayor was delighted to confirm that the Mayor's Cadet for 2019/2020 was Sgt Emily Brown of 1900 (West Cornwall) Squadron, ATC, who had served the mayor diligently the previous year. The mayor congratulated her on the appointment in her absence and hoped she would be well soon.


